





The RedRover Relief Urgent Care grant program helps animals who need urgent and emergency veterinary care. Decisions are based upon several factors, including medical urgency, financial need, available funding, and eligibility. Once an application has been submitted, you can expect to receive a response by email or phone within one to two business days. The typical grant is around \$200.
